

## 'STUDENTS IN BUSINESS' 2024 - WEEK 2

DOWNTON BREWERY

This week our Year 8 students continued their 'Students in Business' visits to local businesses as part of their careers education programme.



On Monday we visited Downton Brewery where we spoke to the owner, Martin. Martin really encouraged our students to get experience in the workplace either through part-time jobs or volunteering. These opportunities will help young people to try out different industries and support their choices for the future. Also, these experiences are key to building your communication skills and your ability to listen and talk with other people in a polite and friendly manner.



Next we toured at Downton Tyre and Autocare, where we heard from the owner, Anton, all about apprenticeships as an excellent way into the motor industry, particularly for Motor Technicians. Anton currently employs 2 apprentices and our students had the opportunity to talk to one of the apprentices who gave them an insight into the reality of working and studying towards a qualification.



Our final visit of the week took us to Wilton Wholefoods where we met Sol, one of the business owners. They employ 20 members of staff, including some of our very own Year 9 & 10 students. Sol spoke to the group about the fact that everything that our students are learning at school can be applied to the workplace in the working world. For example, Food Tech teaches many aspects of food hygiene and traceability, Maths teaches weights and measurements, and Business Studies teaches about business ownership and economies of scale.
