

Last Friday, we had a 'Careers LIVE Tutor Time Takeover' where every tutor group watched a broadcast hosted by the Swindon and Wiltshire Careers Hub, part of The Careers and Enterprise Company.

The students watched a video that started with an introduction to Apprenticeships and Technical Education qualifications from ASK, and also featured experts from Wiltshire College University Centre and New College, Swindon. They outlined the technical education qualifications and apprenticeships that they offer and what learning or training with them is like, as well as information about the careers to which those technical education qualifications or apprenticeships might lead.
